

## **3v3 Live Responsibilities for Safe Play**

### **3v3 Live Responsibilities**

- Fields will be spaced out with no less than 30 feet between fields.
- Align teams (and their spectators) on opposite sides of the field
- Ensure 9 foot "parking spaces" for spectators - separated by 6 foot "no parking zones" - marked on fields to allow for social distancing.
- Encourage families/spectators to wear masks and social distance from other families
- After each game spectators will be asked to leave the sideline area to create room for the spectators of the next game.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at check-in.
- Temperature checks for all tournament staff & referees.
- Tournament staff will wear masks.
- Option to turn in signed waivers and paperwork to TD via email to avoid in person check in process.
- 6-foot marks at check-in and outside of restrooms to allow for social distancing when waiting in line.
- Allow for no contact pick up of medals by coaches (no awards ceremony)

### **Player Responsibilities**

- Bring and use hand sanitizer
- Encouraged to wear a face mask when not competing in a game or practicing.
- Do not touch or share anyone else's water bottles, towels, or clothing.
- Practice social distancing, place bags and equipment at least 6 feet apart.
- No group hand shakes, high fives, or team "huddles".

### **Coach Responsibilities**

- Ensure the health and safety of the athletes.
- Inquire how the athletes are feeling, send them home should you believe they act or look ill.
- Keep players 6ft apart on sidelines. At halftime keep 3 players on the field to allow distancing.
- Ensure athletes are not sharing water bottles, snacks, towels, or clothing.
- Encouraged to wear a face mask, when not actively coaching and maintain social distance requirements from players based on state and local health requirements.
- Have fun, stay positive – players and parents are looking to you to stay calm, supportive, and caring during this time.

### **Spectator/Parent Responsibilities**

- Ensure your child is healthy, check your child's temperature prior to arriving at the fields.
- Encouraged to wear a mask when in higher concentrated areas of the park.
- Ensure your family is sitting in a designated space on sideline to maintain social distancing while watching the game.
- Leave the designated spaces on sideline when the game you are watching is over to create room for the next team's spectators
- Be sure your child has necessary sanitizer with them.
